

# Fundamentals for Establishing the Office of International Exchange Program, Central Police University

1. In order to promote the international academic exchange, the University establishes the Office of International Exchange Program (hereinafter referred to as “the Office”) pursuant to Article 13 of the Organic Act for the Central Police University.
2. The Office shall handle the following affairs:
  - (1) Academic exchange with the similar schools of foreign countries.
  - (2) Promotion of the academic exchange between the University and foreign academic institutions.
  - (3) Assistance for foreign students to study in the University.
  - (4) Other affairs related to international academic exchange.
3. In the Office there shall be 5~7 committeemen, which are assumed by the teachers who are good at foreign languages and thus are selected by the president. One of them shall assume the position of chief committeemen to preside over the Office.
4. The tenure of committeemen is two years, and their rights and obligations are similarly as prescribed in the related regulations on the teachers who concurrently hold administrative positions.
5. In the Office shall be set a clerk, which is assumed by an administrative worker.
6. These Fundamentals will take effect after being approved.
